



Dayamineral[®] Liquid Security Features

(Central American Countries Only)

As part of Abbott's ongoing effort to enhance patient safety and combat counterfeiting of pharmaceutical products, Abbott is incorporating security features into Dayamineral Liquid packaging materials in Central American countries. This transition will require several months to complete. Please exercise normal due diligence prior to dispensing or using existing inventories of Dayamineral Liquid that do not have the new features.

For your security please note:

1. Dayamineral Liquid bottles have a tamper-evident shrink band around the closure. The shrink band has a silver security tear-strip with a repeating pattern of Abbott logos within circles. While situated beneath a good light source that is slightly behind you and while holding the bottle upright, the Abbott logo will be sideways. The Abbott logo will be bright and colorful in contrast to the circles when the bottle is straight up or when the cap is tilted slightly away from you, depending on the location of the light source (1a). When the Abbott logo appears bright and colorful, turn the bottle 90 degrees to the left or right so the Abbott logo is right side up. The circles and "Abbott" will appear bright and colorful as you slowly rotate the bottle back and forth (1b).
2. Dayamineral Liquid bottle labels are printed with color-shifting ink. When viewed at one angle, the ink appears violet in color. When changing the viewing angle, the ink gradually changes colors from violet to green.
3. You should accept a Dayamineral Liquid bottle only if the security features behave as described above. Please contact Abbott immediately if you suspect that you have received counterfeit Dayamineral Liquid.
